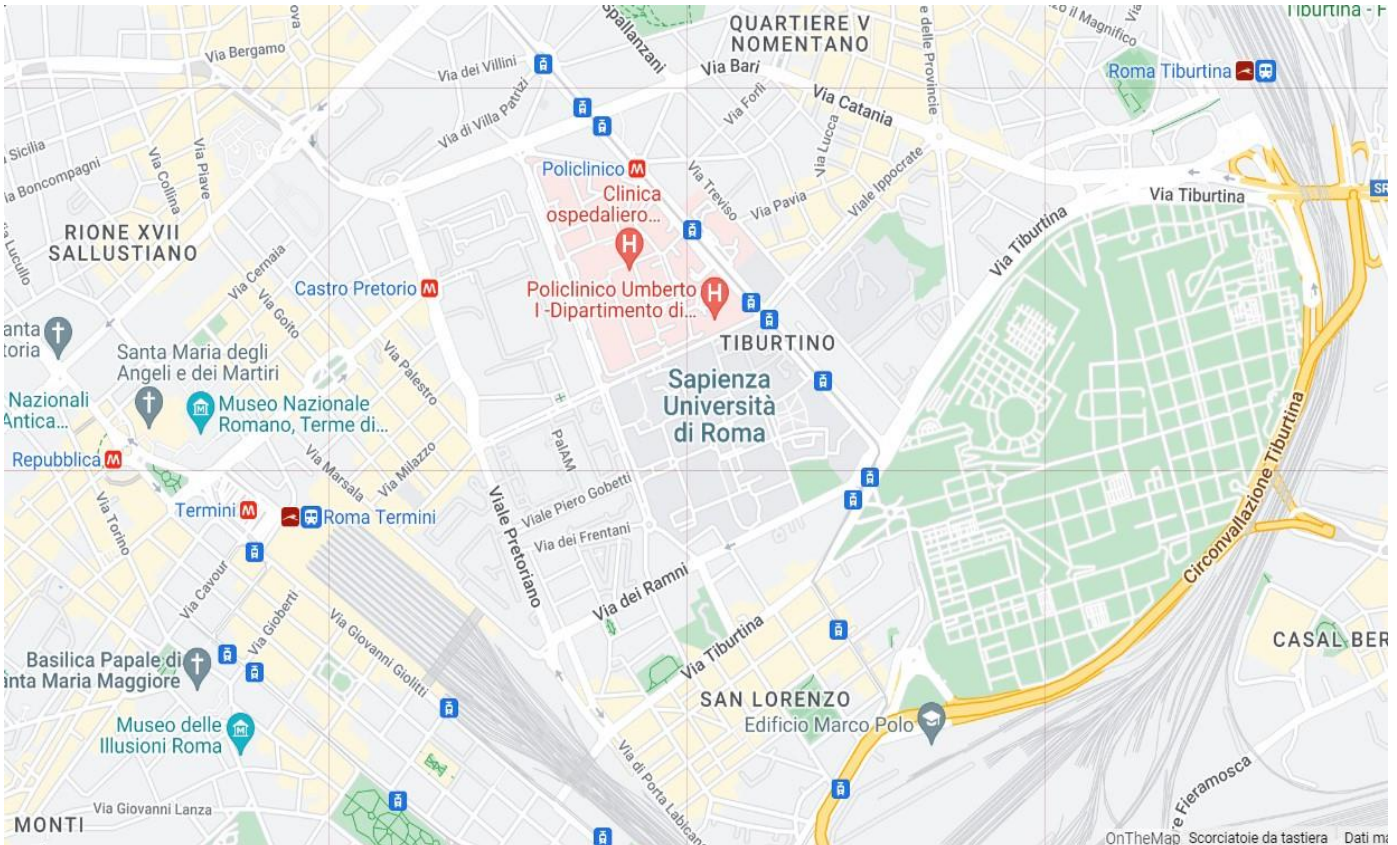


How to Reach Sapienza Università di Roma

Sapienza University is located at walking distance (15 minutes from Termini Train Station)



From Airports:

The International Airport / Aeroporto Intercontinentale di Roma - Fiumicino "Leonardo da Vinci" is connected with Roma Termini Train Station (the main Station in Rome) with a direct train called LEONARDO EXPRESS (31 minutes from Airport to Termini Station, price 14 Euro). There is also a slower train connecting Fiumicino Aeroporto with Termini station, leaving from Airport every 15 minutes (53 minutes, price 8 Euro)

The International Airport / Aeroporto Internazionale di Roma - Ciampino "Giovanni Battista Pastine" is connected with Metro Station Line A Anagnina, from where you can get the Metro to Roma Termini. Alternatively, you can reach Termini Station with Terravision Shuttle and Schiaffini Buses (6/7 Euro)

From Termini Train Station:

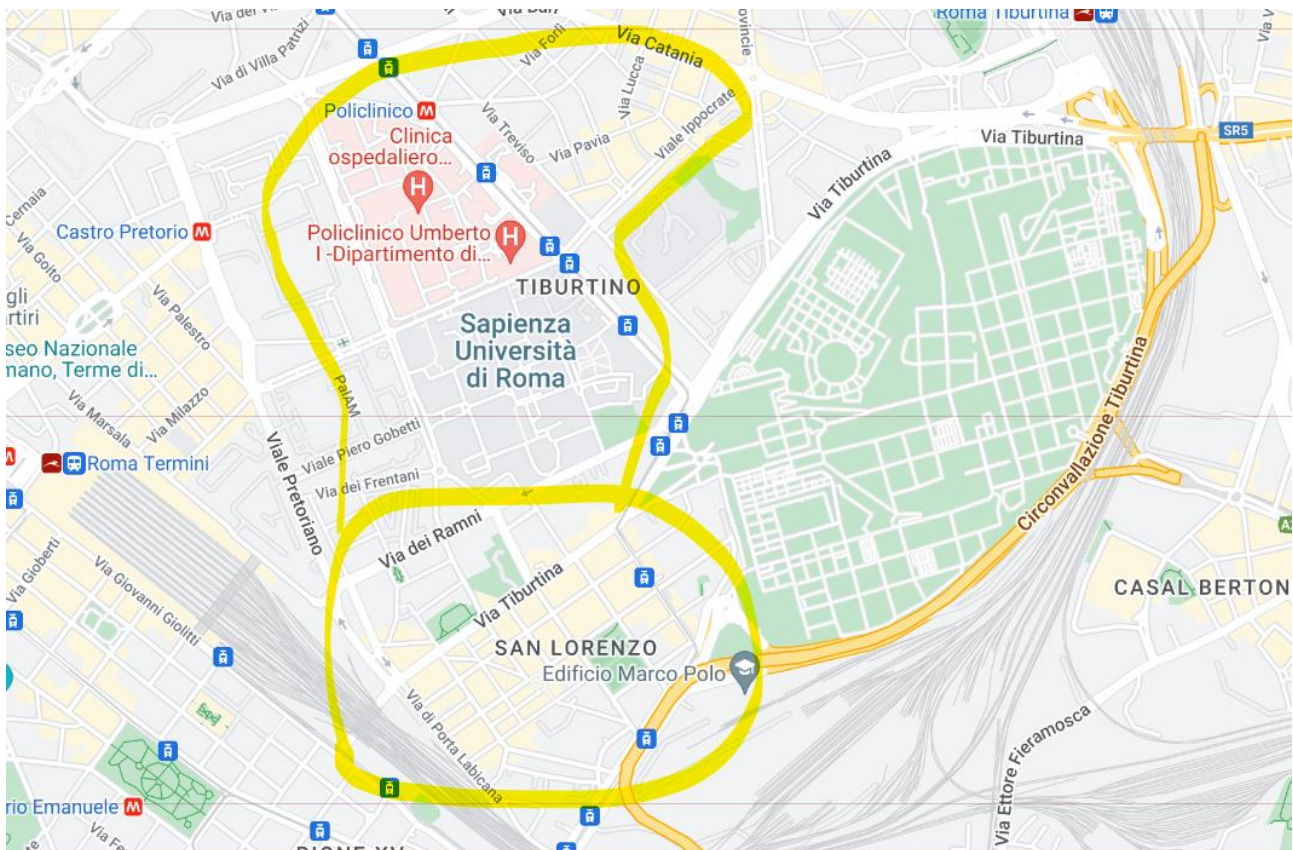
From Termini station you can walk or take BUS number 310 up to “Università/Regina Elena” stop.

The University is also conveniently close to two Metro (Line B) stations: “Policlinico” and “Castro Pretorio” (a ten minutes’ walk to the University gates)

Accommodation Tips

For accommodation: unfortunately, the University Guest Houses are under renovation so we advise you to book your hotel, b&b, or hostel as soon as possible. Rome is a popular destination and the more so in June.

If possible, try to secure a room in the highlighted parts of the map below. Ideally in San Lorenzo area, which is very close to the University and is a lively students’ hub, with several bars and restaurants serving the authentic local foods.
